VISA REQUIREMENTS

Are exchange students eligible to work?	Exchange students coming under a study permit (not ETA) are eligible to work on or off campus as per the guidelines of their study permit.

Notes

1. Lakehead University International offers a free airport pick-up service for all new exchange students.
2. Lakehead University requires all international and exchange students to be registered in the Guard.Me health insurance plan at a rate of approximately \$1.65 CAD per day.
3. All new exchange students will receive a Welcome Package containing information pertinent to their arrival (Orientation, Accommodations, Guard.Me, and more).

HOW TO APPLY

If you wish to apply to study abroad at Lakehead University, follow these three easy steps. Once you have completed the application process, we will contact you with more information.

- 1 **NOMINATION**
You must be nominated to Lakehead University by your home institution or exchange coordinator. You must have your home co-ordinator complete and submit the Nomination Form, and send it to: studyabroad@lakeheadu.ca
- 2 **APPLY**
After submitting the Nomination Form, please complete and submit the Incoming Exchange Application Form. For Fee-Paying Graduate Exchange Students, please complete and submit the Study Abroad Application Form for Graduate Students. Submit these forms to: studyabroad@lakeheadu.ca
- 3 **SUBMIT YOUR SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS**
Along with these forms, you must also submit two supporting documents to studyabroad@lakeheadu.ca: an official copy of your academic transcripts; and a letter of attestation from your home institution stating that you are proficient in the English language. For Graduate (Masters) Fee Paying Exchange students, you must also submit proof of degree.
