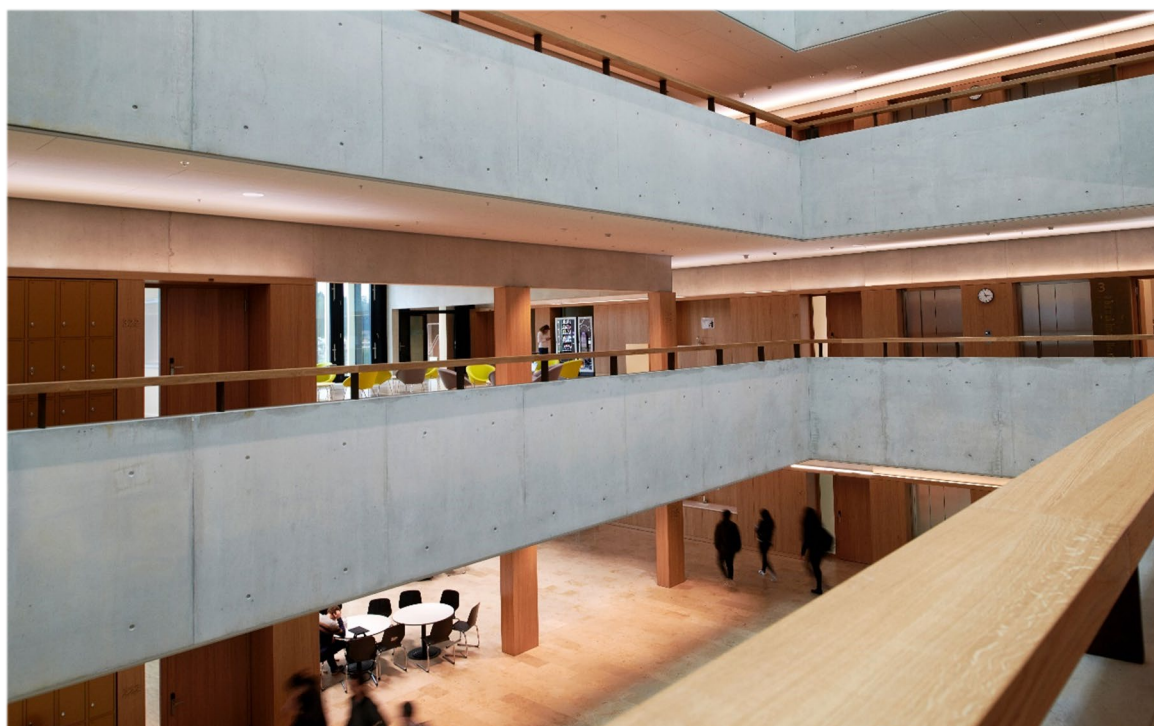

<b>Grading System</b>	From 1 – 6 (6 is the best grade, 1 is the lowest grade. Passing grade is 4)
<b>ECTS System</b>	The Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts fully subscribes to the ECTS System and allocates ECTS credits to all undergraduate and postgraduate programs. In line with ECTS requirements, 60 credits measure the workload of a full-time student during one academic year.
<b>Full-time Study Load</b>	max. 30 ECTS per Semester
<b>Language Requirements</b>	Proof of English Proficiency at least B2 level (if applying for courses taught in English and if not mother tongue) or Proof of German Proficiency at least B2 level (if applying for courses taught in German and if not mother tongue)
<b>Language Courses</b>	The University offers a range of language courses in its <a href="#">language centre</a> .

<sup>1</sup> All incoming students are expected to stay in Switzerland till end of the exam period. If this is not possible, the student is responsible for contacting the lecturers and the International Office in order to organize the exams accordingly.

<b>Course Registration</b>	The exchange programme coordinator of the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts will do the course registration for you according to your predefined learning agreement.
<b>Transcripts of Records</b>	Transcripts are generally available few weeks after the final exams. The Exchange Programme Coordinator will send the official transcript to the student's home institution and a copy to the student by email.
