Nevertheless YOUC program is not a language training program; however, it provides a great opportunity to acquire Japanese proficiency.</p>														
<b>Accommodation</b>	YOUC students are eligible to live in on-campus housing which is less than 5 minute walk from the center of campus.

<b>Entry and Residence</b>	<p>Student visa is required for all the students.</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b>  1: Submit an Application for Certificate of Eligibility (CoE) to OUC. OUC will apply for your CoE to the Sapporo Immigration Bureau on behalf of students to send the certificate to your home institution as soon as it is issued.  2: Submit your CoE with your visa application when you apply for a visa at your nearest Japanese embassy.</p>
