OUC. OUC will apply for your CoE to the Immigration Bureau
on behalf of students. Please note that the CoE will be issued in a
form of e-mail and there is no its original hardcopy. As soon as
the CoE is issued, OUC will send it to your home institution via e-
mail.
2: Submit your CoE with your visa application when you apply
for a visa at your nearest Japanese embassy.
