# Acceptance and Visa Procedures

After being accepted by CAU, students are responsible for obtaining their visas. Students must prepare required documents beforehand individually and visit the Korean Embassy/ Consulate/Visa Centre in their home countries to apply for a valid student visa.

\* Students from the following 26 countries may be requested additional financial documents: Bangladesh, Cameroon, China, Egypt, Ethiopia, Ghana, Guinea, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, India, Indonesia, Iran, Mali, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Ukraine, Uganda, Uzbekistan, Vietnam

# About Student Visa (D-2-6)

1. Student must enter Korea with a valid D-2-6 Student Visa. (Not a Tourist Visa)

Students must obtain their Student Visa (D-2-6) at least a week before the semester begins. Without a proper Student Visa (D-2-6), students cannot study at CAU.

- \* Students who enter Korea with a Tourist Visa cannot change it into a Student Visa (D-2-6) in Korea.
- 2. Please do not use your Student Visa (D-2-6) to travel to Korea before the semester starts and go back to your home country (or to a third country), since the Student Visa (D-2-6) is for single-entry.

If you want to come earlier and travel with your Student Visa (D-2-6), you cannot leave Korea until you create your RC (Registration Card). If you do leave, the student visa will automatically be terminated and you will no longer be able to study at CAU as an exchange student.

3. After arrival, students must create an RC (Registration Card).

The RC is mandatory for all exchange students, and it acts as a legal permit, which allows students to live in Korea for their entire study period, as well as exit and enter the country freely. Students wishing to leave the country after arrival must book their RC appointment at the Immigration Office in advance of leaving the country so that they can gain re-entry permission. CAU offers group RC application service, so students do not have to make individual appointments. It takes about 7-10 weeks to receive the RC.

- 4. Students should leave Korea within 30 days of the semester-end date, regardless of the expiration date of RC.
- \* Although the RC may be valid after the semester ends, the OIA will terminate the student's visa on the last day of semester. Therefore, those who are not staying for another exchange semester SHOULD depart within 30 days after semester ends.

#### Orientation and Arrival Date

CAU provides on-campus orientation held the week before semester starts. Students are recommended to arrive at least a day before the orientation.

Students living on campus should arrive between the dormitory check in period. It is usually 2 to 3 days before the semester begins. The dormitory check in period will be announced later to accepted students via email. Any student arriving earlier than the official move-in date of the dormitory should find their own accommodation until they can move-in.

Students who wish to live in on-campus dormitory needs to apply through the online application page from a link provided by the OIA, which will be sent when the dormitory dates are fixed.

It is on a first-come, first-served basis. Please make sure to not miss the deadline as the dormitory availability is very limited and competitive.

If a student wants to cancel the application for the dormitory, they need to **give notice at least three weeks before the beginning of the semester** by emailing <a href="mailto:inbound@cau.ac.kr">inbound@cau.ac.kr</a>. If a student cancels their dormitory application after this period, they may still need to pay the dormitory fee, depending on the dormitory's refund policy.

A Tuberculosis (TB) Test result in English or Korean, taken within 4 weeks before the dormitory move-in date is also required. The test should include student's name, hospital/clinic name,

	date of the test, and test results in English/Korean. The test can be conducted in Korea, and
	in the form of a skin test, blood test, or X-ray. Please bring the original test result to the
	dormitory move-in.
Tuition and	Fee-paying students must pay the tuition in full to CAU by the given tuition payment period.
<b>Dormitory Payment</b>	The dormitory fee must be paid in full during the announced dorm payment period for
	exchange students. Once the exact period is released, students will be informed by email.
	Students are recommended to withdraw cash and bring the required amount in advance
	when entering Korea. Late payments are unacceptable. As the dorm office will not accept
	overseas payment, students are recommended to withdraw enough cash for the dorm fee
	and bring them when entering Korea to make domestic transaction.
Course Registration	Students may take courses from different departments and colleges with certain restrictions.
Restrictions	The following are the restrictions students should be aware of regarding course enrollment:
	1. During the 1 <sup>st</sup> course registration period, all other majors <b>CANNOT</b> enroll in <b>business</b>
	courses and art courses. Business majors can enroll in any courses from all majors,
	except art courses. This is due to the high competition in the business department.
	2. Only art majors can enroll in art courses during all three course registration periods.
	3. Exchange students who would like to take courses in the School of Architecture and
	Building Science (College of Engineering): 1) Should be majoring in a similar major in
	their home universities 2) Should have taken the prerequisite courses if required by CAU
	3) The home university must be accredited for Architecture / Architectural Engineering.
	* If students enrol in incorrect courses, it will be notified by email before the semester starts.
	* The course registration detail may be canceled regardless of student's situation depending
	on the course restrictions.
National Health	ALL international students are subject to a mandatory subscription to the National Health
Insurance Service	Insurance Service (NHIS), operated by the Korean government. The subscription is automatic.
	The NHIS will be active once the registration number is issued, and a bill will be sent to each
	student's Korean address, which is one put when applying for RC.
