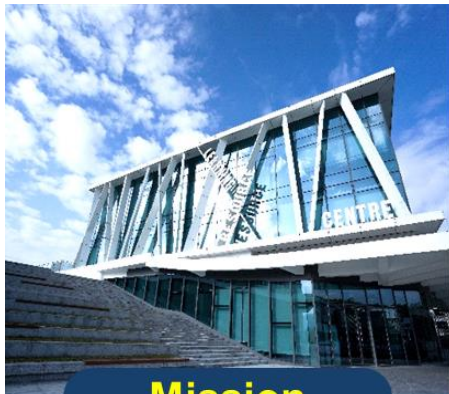


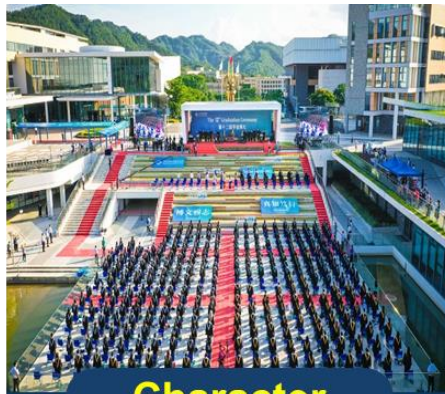

## HOW TO APPLY

---

- HKBU will nominate students to UIC International Development Office in accordance with mutually agreed number of exchange places.
- HKBU students need to complete the application form and upload all required documents online via <https://p.uic.edu.cn/itraining/ido/login/index>.
- Student Visa Application: All students must have the “Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macao Residents” and valid through the whole studying period. \*International passport holders please consult IO/ UIC-IDO for guidance during the Pandemic.

## Required Documents

1. Certificate of Enrollment.
2. Official Academic Transcript (The attainment of cGPA2.5 or above is required).
3. One Recommendation from Global Engagement Office of HKBU and One Recommendation from Academic Advisor.
4. One copy of your Hong Kong ID and Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macao Residents.
5. Copy of Insurance, please purchase adequate insurance in Hong Kong.

① Make an appointment on the WeChat APP of "Shenzhen Local Bao" to reserve the quarantine hotel in Shenzhen.

## How to Arrive

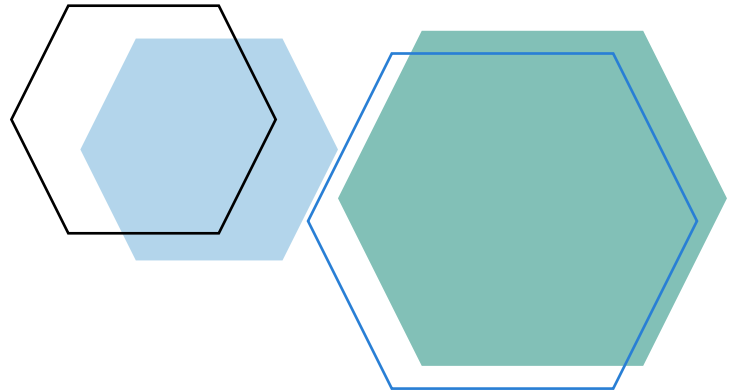
### FOUR STEPS FROM HONG KONG TO MAINLAND CHINA

1. Apply the Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macao Residents.

2. How to Enter the Mainland China from Hong Kong?

3. When crossing the Border of Shenzhen or Zhuhai, you need to hold a paper report of negative COVID 19 test results within 24 hours.

4. The current mainland quarantine policy: 14-day hotel centralized quarantine + 7-day home health test (or at a quarantine hotel if you do not have a home in Zhuhai or Shenzhen).



### **The current mainland quarantine policy:**

14-day hotel centralized quarantine + 7-day home health test (or at a quarantine hotel if you do not have a home in Zhuhai or Shenzhen)

14-day compulsory quarantine and COVID-19 test on the 1st, 4th, 7th, and 14th days;

7-day home health monitoring, and COVID-19 test on the 15th and 21st days.

Please note:

\*The above information is as of February 22, 2021.

\*Please pay close attention to "Shenzhen Local Bao" and "Zhuhai Local Bao" WeChat public account for entry policy and quarantine policy.

\*Home health monitoring is not allowed to leave their home/hotel.



**\*For international passport holders, please consult the International Office for travel restrictions during the pandemic.**
