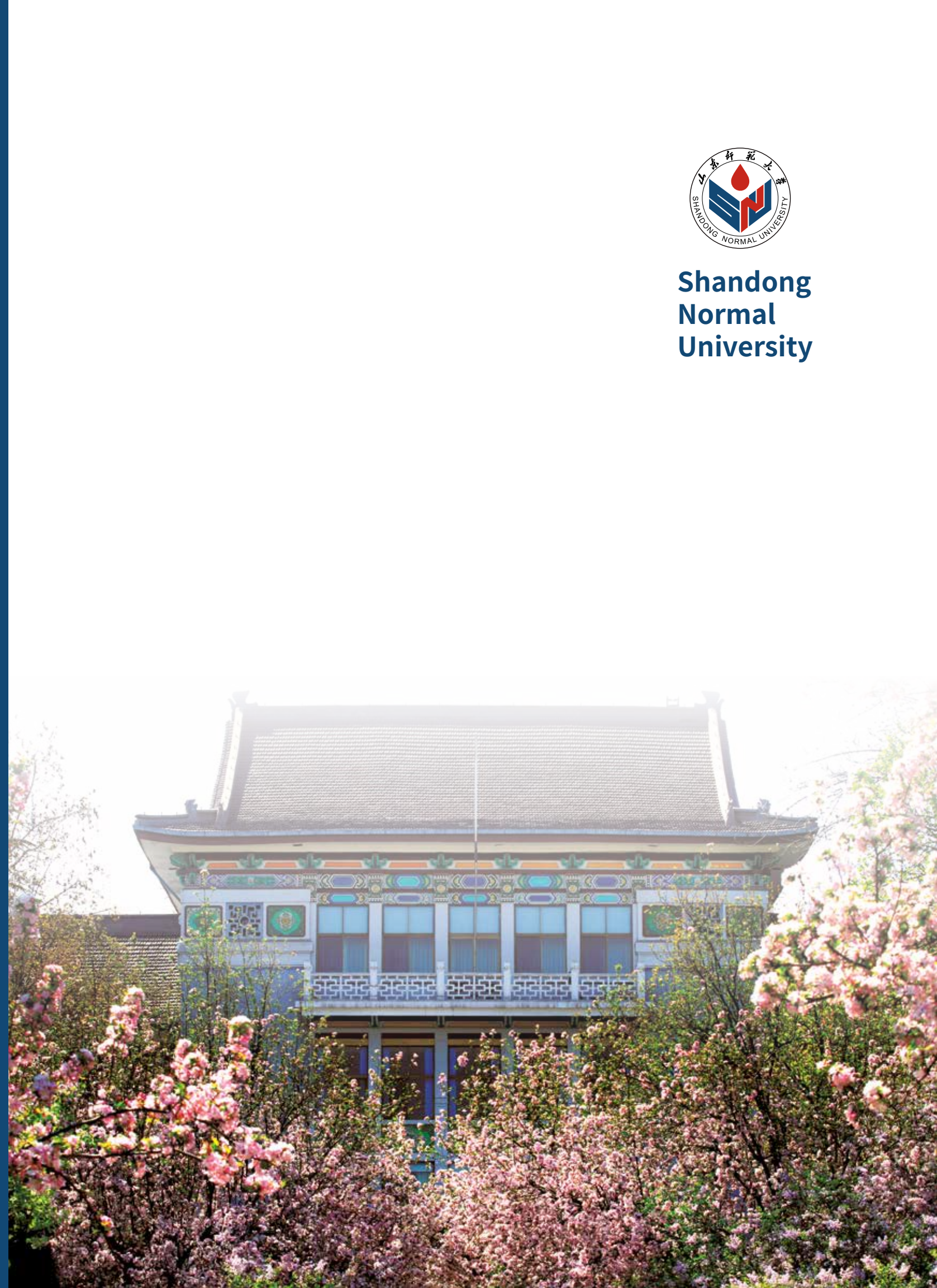

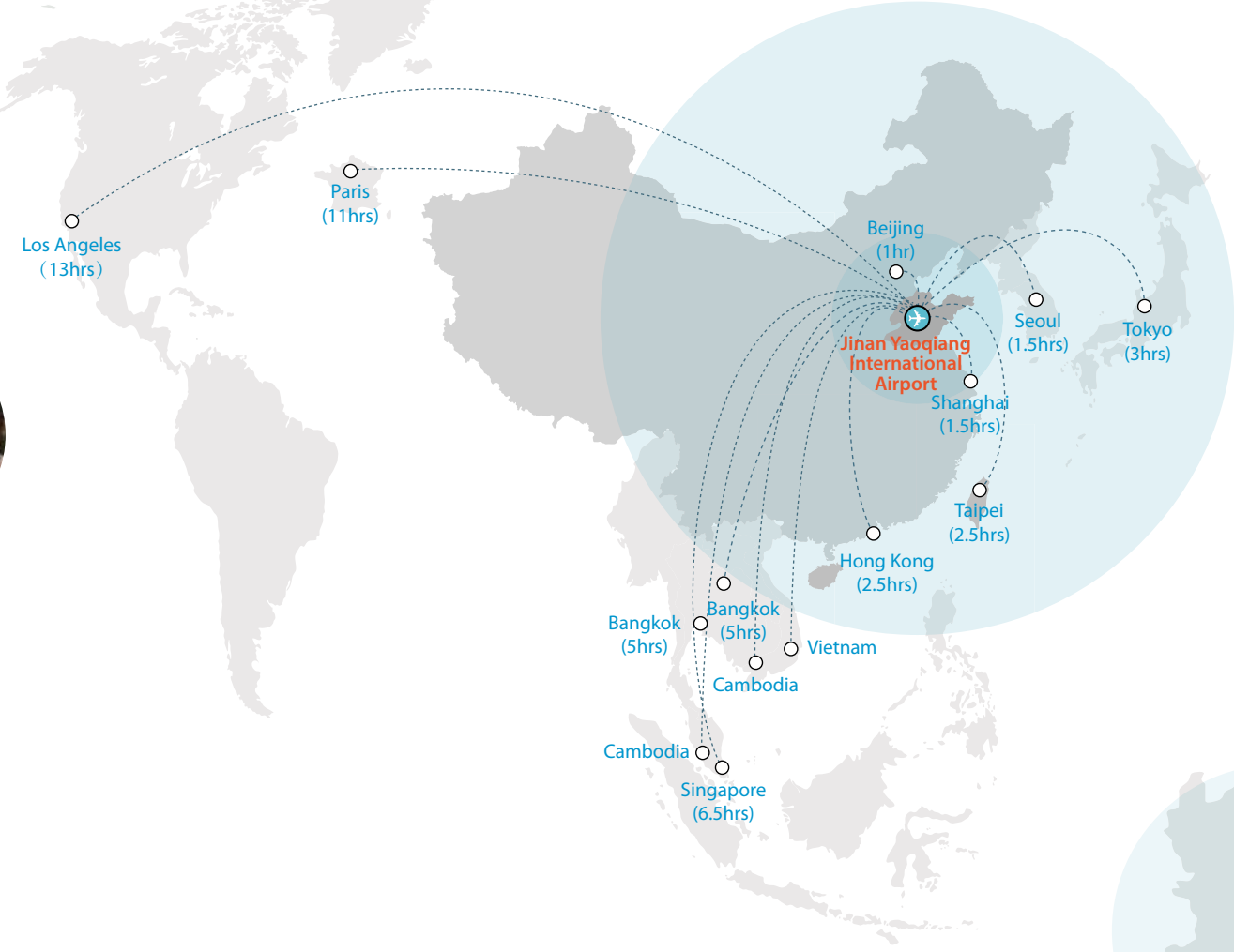
OUR LOCATION



Shandong Normal University is located in Jinan, capital city of Shandong, a province half way between Beijing and Shanghai in East China. The province connects China's far-flung inland with the vast west Pacific and faces across the sea Japan and Republic of Korea. As home to a population of 101.527 million, Shandong covers a land area of 157.1 thousand square kilometers and a marine area of 170 thousand square kilometers. The coastline of Shandong stretches 3,345 kilometers long, accounting for 1/6 of China's total. Shandong has under its jurisdiction 16 municipalities, including Jinan, the provincial capital, and 137 counties (county-level cities, districts).

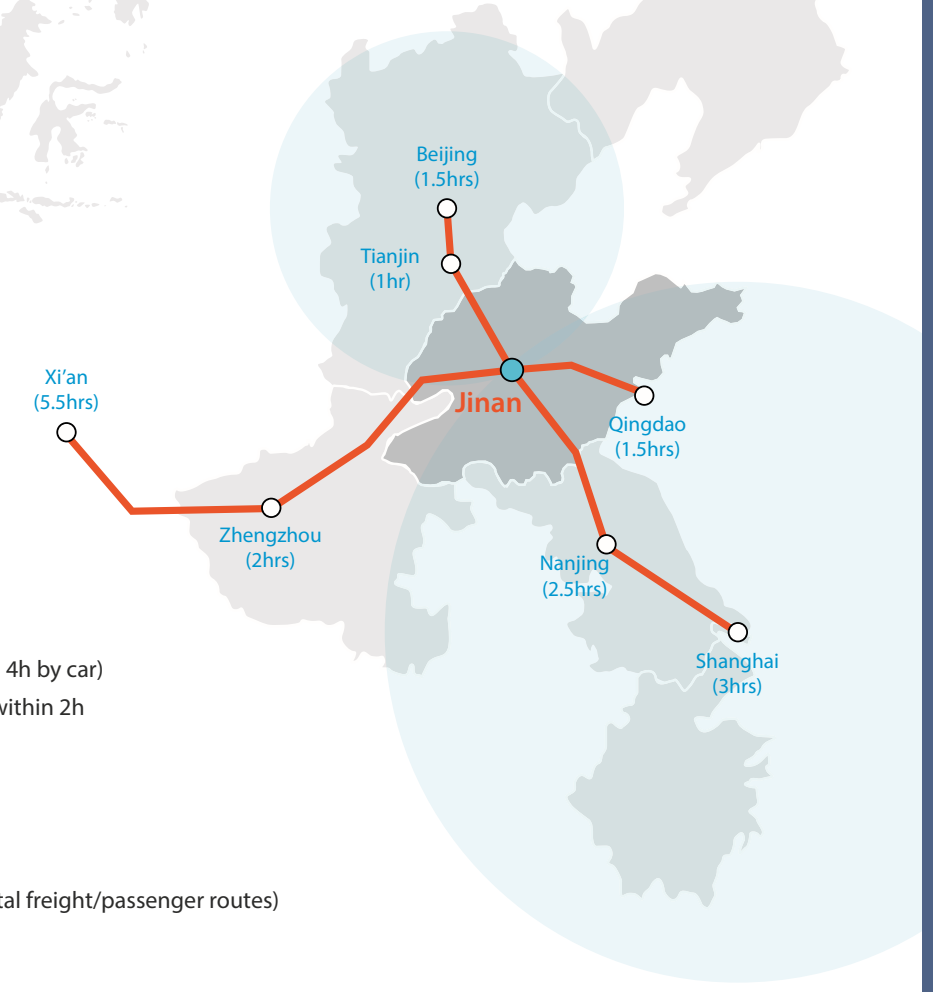

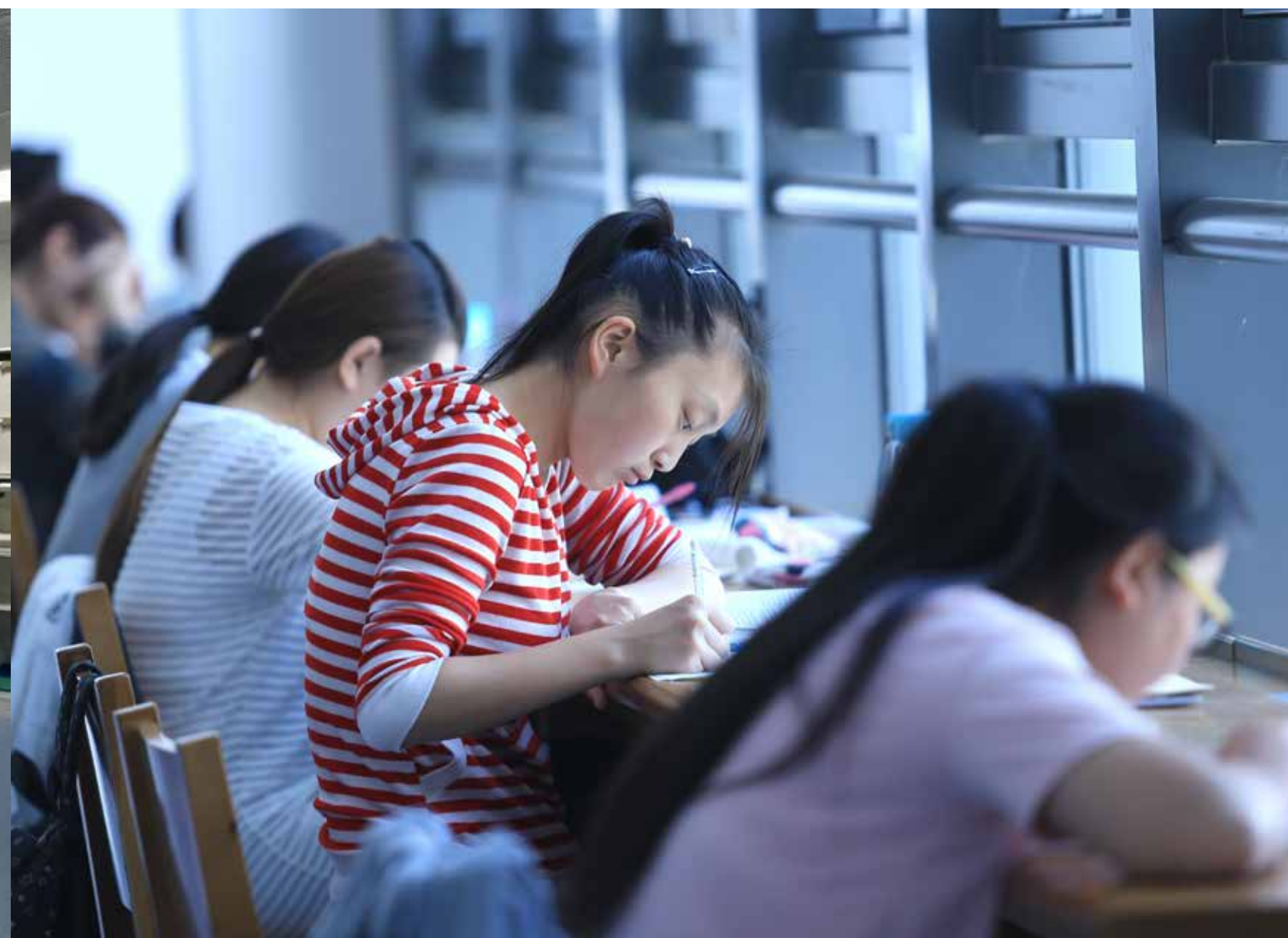

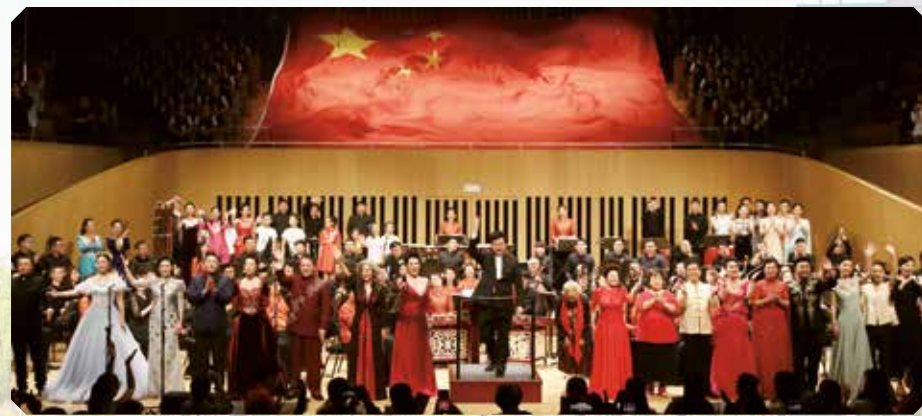
Guo Xusheng

Cao Xuetao

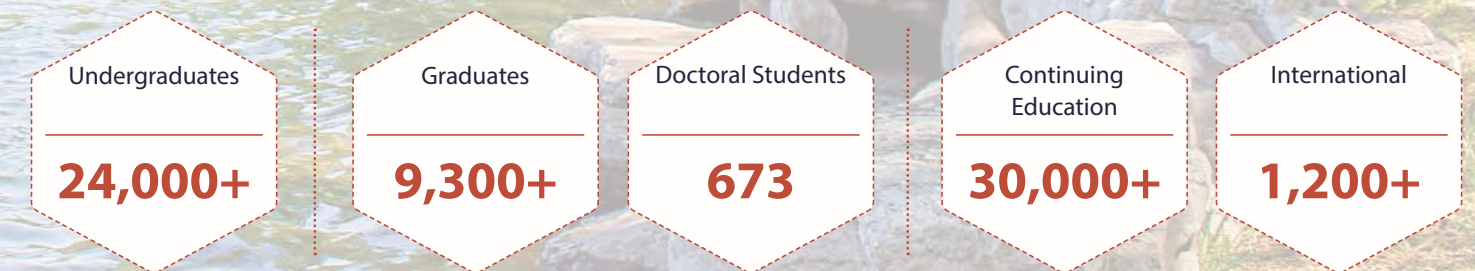

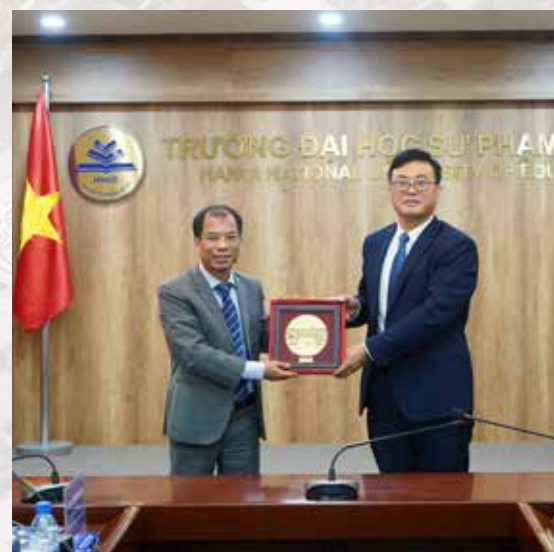

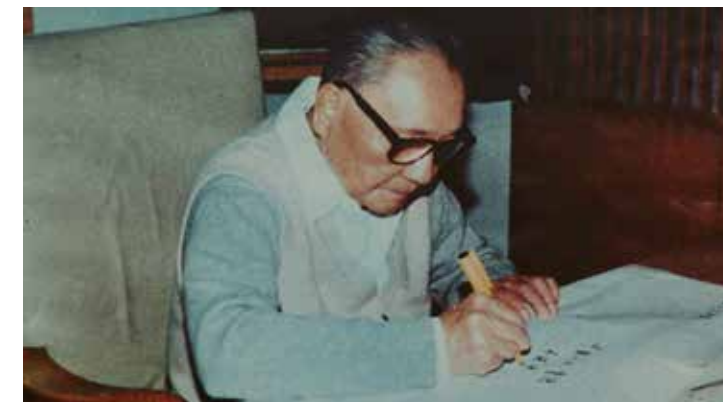
MODES OF INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

01 Relations of Friendship and Cooperation

On the basis of equality and mutual benefit and through friendly consultations, SDNU is open to establish relations of friendship between universities, or establish such relations between departments of the same or similar nature, according to the actual needs of relevant parties. Our university wishes to establish substantive exchange programs within the framework of partner institution agreements.

02 Faculty Exchange Programs

Faculty exchange programs allow teachers to be sent to their partner institutions as visiting scholars, who are expected to exchange ideas with their colleagues in such aspects as teaching, curriculum arrangement and instructional skills. It is hoped that these visiting scholars can learn from the educational experiences of their overseas colleagues so as to enhance their teaching standards, promote research exchanges and pave the way for exploring international cooperation in other fields.



In May 1991, China Population, Resources and Environment, a National Journal compiled by our university, was founded. Former President Deng Xiaoping handwrote the title for the journal.

03 Research Collaborations

As globalization becomes more pervasive, research collaborations are playing an increasingly important role in economic development, technology and higher education. Effective partnering globally has also developed a deeper understanding between different cultures.

SDNU expects and encourages collaborations between scholars of our university and their international counterparts regarding such issues as consulting on academic topics of mutual concern, implementing relevant research projects and coauthoring academic papers. We also expect to invite internationally acclaimed scholars to give lectures on a short or long-term basis, to establish cooperative research centers, and to co-sponsor international symposia with overseas education institutions.



04 Student Joint-training Programs

Student Exchange Program:

On the basis of equality and mutual benefit, SDNU hopes to send students to a partner institution in exchange for a comparable number of their counterparts (in the same or similar academic area). The terms are applicable to both undergraduate and graduate students.

Undergraduate Student Mobility Programs:

Within the framework of the 4-year undergraduate system, these programs allow SDNU undergraduates to study in the same or similar department of a partner institution. These students shall complete their first 2 or 3 years of university education at SDNU, followed by their last 1 or 2 years of study abroad after admission by the partner institution. Course credits shall be transferred from SDNU to the partner institution. Once the participating students have met the degree requirements of both universities, they will be granted graduation certificates and bachelor's degrees from both institutions.

Graduate Mobility Programs:

SDNU will send graduates to study in the same or similar department for 1 or more academic years. Course credits shall be transferred from SDNU to the partner institution. Once the participating students have met the degree requirements of both universities, they will be granted graduation certificates and master's or doctor's degrees from both institutions unless other requirements must be met.

Study Abroad Program:

SDNU sends students to a partner institution to participate in short-term cultural experiences and academic training during summer or winter vacations. After successful completion of this program, students will be given relevant course credits, which can be transferred to SDNU.

05 Co-establishment of Confucius Institute

Ratified by Chinese International Education Foundation and funded by Center for Language Education and Cooperation, Confucius Institutes are non-profit organizations established by Chinese educational institutions and operated in cooperation with colleges and universities around the world. Their mission is to enhance the global understanding of Chinese language and culture, to deepen friendly relations with other nations and to promote multiculturalism development.

Confucius Institutes are dedicated to facilitating worldwide educational, cultural and economic exchanges and cooperation. SDNU has established eight Confucius Institutes at Woosuk University in Republic of Korea in 2008, Kenyatta University in Kenya in 2009, Pará State University in Brazil in 2014, Central Connecticut State University, USA in 2014, University of Jeddah in Saudi Arabia in 2020 and Edmonton in Canada in 2021, one Confucius Classroom based on Private Institution Educational Organization of Supplementary Education "Confucius" Oriental Languages & Culture Academy in Russia in 2020, Sharjah, UAE in 2025. Varied and colorful language-learning and culture-promoting activities conducted by Confucius Institutes (Classroom) have facilitated mutual understanding, mutual friendship and educational cooperation home and abroad.



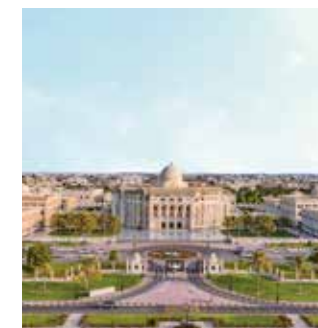

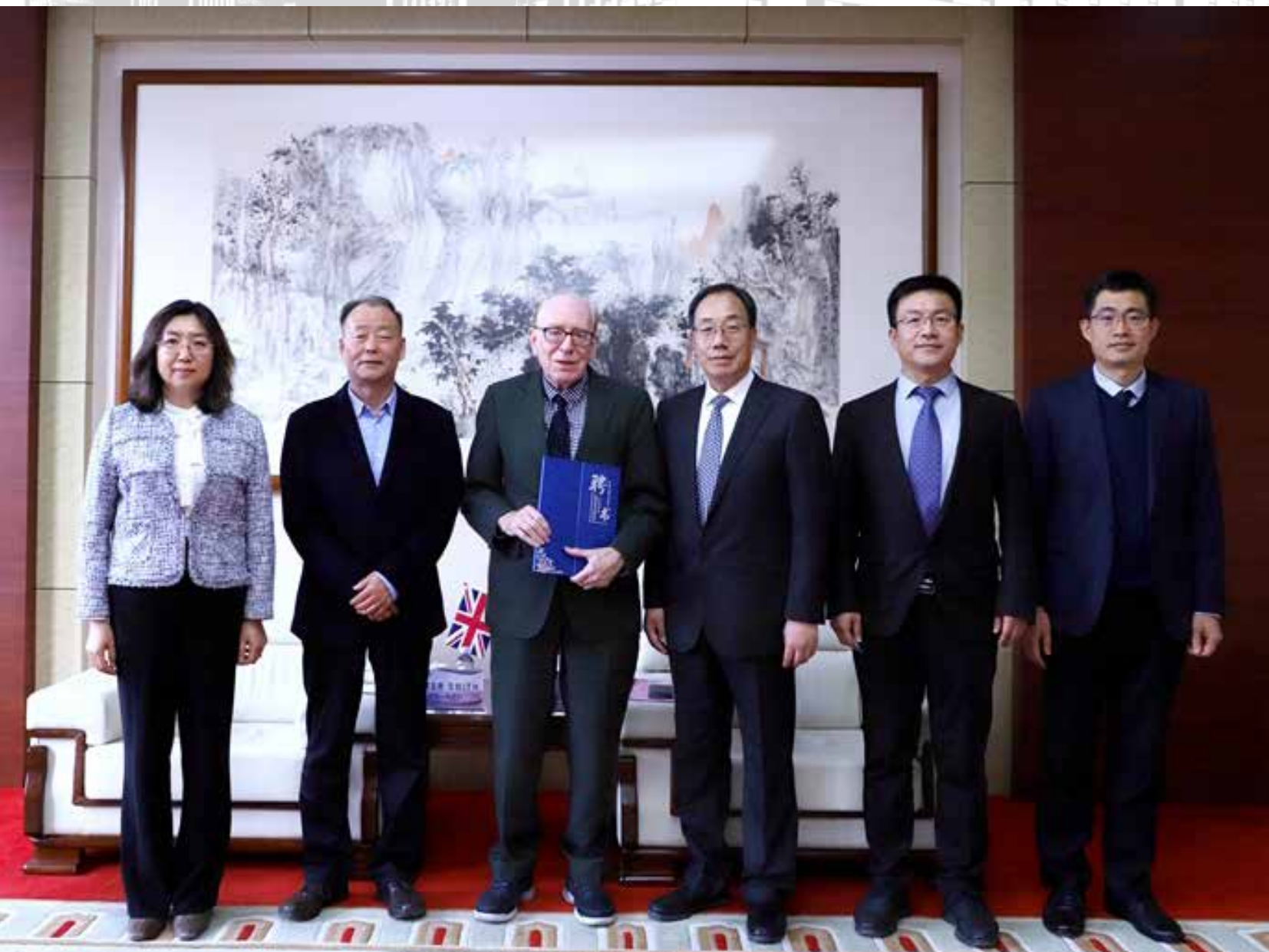
06 International Faculty

SDNU has a long history of employing foreign experts to teach in its academic departments. In recent years, with the development of international cooperation, the number of international faculty has increased rapidly, and SDNU has invited more than 140 foreign experts from more than 20 countries worldwide each year to carry out research programs at the university.

SDNU is constantly striving to strengthen its top-quality international faculty through recruitment and institutional collaboration. The university invites foreign scholars to China for short-term collaboration and welcomes scholars who are willing to come to China. SDNU currently employs more than 30 long-term international faculty from more than nine countries each year. Their contributions facilitate SDNU's globalization efforts and enhance its status as a national top university.

07 International Students

SDNU began to admit international students as early as 1983. It is among the first group of universities approved by the Ministry of Education of China to enroll international students, including those supported by Chinese Government Scholarships. SDNU is also among the first group of universities to enroll international students supported by Confucius Institute Scholarships and provincial government scholarships.

SDNU has welcomed and educated more than 20,000 short-term and long-term international students from over 70 countries and has become a window of Shandong Province to the world. SDNU can provide Chinese Government Scholarships, Confucius Institute Scholarships and Shandong Provincial Scholarships covering both degree and non-degree programs. Short-term training and summer school programs are also open to all international students. Currently there are more than 1,000 overseas students registered and enrolled by SDNU.
