<b>Application Procedure</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Student Nomination</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Nomination will be done online via a link sent to universities that have been approved to send students to Konkuk University. The email containing detailed information and link will be sent in late March for fall semester and late September for spring semester</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>Student Application</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Nominated student(s) will be sent a link to access our online application form</li> <li>The following documents will be required to complete the online application: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Official academic transcript in English (issued by home university)</li> <li>Copy of passport (personal profile page)</li> <li>Recent color photo (3.5cm x 4.5cm) [for student ID card issuance]</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> </ol>

Konkuk University does not facilitate off-campus housing.
<b>Living Costs</b>	USD 400~600 / month (varies depending upon the lifestyle of students)
<b>Visa</b>	All exchange students must obtain a D-2-6 (exchange student) visa in order to study at Konkuk University. Upon admission, students will receive the 'Certificate of Admission' which is required to apply for the visa. Students should contact the Korean consulate in their home countries for details.
<b>Medical Insurance</b>	All exchange students must purchase overseas health insurance which covers their study period prior to coming to Korea & enrol in the Korean National Health Insurance after arriving in Korea.
<b>Facilities</b>	University hospital, library, computer rooms, on-campus dormitory, cafeterias, adjacent subway (metro) system, adjacent shopping malls, etc.
