- 6. Transcript issued by the home university
- 7. English or Chinese language test certificate (The native speaker is exempt from presenting the certificate.)
- 8. Photocopy of the personal page of the passport
- 9. Headshot

NCCU offers courses English-taught in all fields of specialization. They are all lectured and supported by NCCU's faculty members. Both degree and non-degree (exchange) students are welcome to register for the course.

IMAS (course code starting with 926), IMBA courses, EMBA and On-Job Training Programs are not available to the exchange student.

#### **Learning Mandarin**

With more than 20 years of history in teaching Mandarin as a foreign language, the Chinese Language Center (CLC) at National Chengchi University (NCCU) aims to provide high-quality and flexible Mandarin courses for students around the world.

Chinese Language Center offers regular Mandarin Chinese courses 4 terms each year. Spring, Summer, and Fall term each last 12 weeks with a total 180 teaching hours; for Winter term, we provide a 10-week course with 150 teaching hours. All CLC courses are divided into beginning, intermediate, high-intermediate, and advanced levels. Students in each level are further grouped into levels 3 to 4 according to individual Chinese language proficiency. #### **Credits Recommended to Take**

9-18 NCCU credits (maximum 25 NCCU credits for undergraduates)

\*Credit Transfer: 1 credit at NCCU = 18 lecture hours = 2 ECTS

#### Accommodation

NCCU will do its utmost to offer on-campus dormitory for international students; some of the dorms are located at uphill campus, and some at downhill. For more information, please visit: https://oic.nccu.edu.tw/Post/433

Besides the dorm fee, the student also needs to pay NTD\$ 1,000 dorm deposit, which will be refunded after checking out if the room is clean and no damage is found.

Off-campus housing fees range from NTD\$ 8,000 to NTD\$ 20,000 per month.

#### Other Expenses (unit: NTD)

#### **Insurance**

- all exchange students:
   Students' Safety Insurance fee of NTD\$ 198 per semester (Required) (The fee varies annually but is usually below NTD\$ 250)
- 1-semester exchange students only:
   Suggested purchase overseas medical insurance in the home country to cover the entire stay in Taiwan. The fee varies in different countries.
- <u>1-year</u> exchange students with ARC (Alien Resident Certificate):
  - (1) Purchase Overseas Medical Insurance in the home country before departure for at least the first 6 months in Taiwan (Sep.-Feb. or Feb.-July). The fee varies in different countries.
  - (2) Required to join the National Health Insurance after 6 months of continuous residence in Taiwan; insurance fee: NTD\$ 826 per month.
