- \$75 Upass Bus pass that will allow you to take the bus anywhere on the island all semester (Without the Upass each ride on the bus is \$2.50)
- \$50 Student Activity Fee so you can take advantage of the assortment of events and activities organized by HPU throughout the semester
- \$120 Passport Week (Orientation) Fee. During Passport Week you will meet other new students and learn all about HPU and living in Hawaii
- \$100 Health Services Fee. This allows students unlimited access to on-campus health services for no additional cost for a routine visit. Other services may have an additional cost.
- Books. Students will be required to purchase books for each class, which can cost \$200 or more per semester. There are rental options and used books available, and you can find the books you will need for each class here.
