How many classes/credits constitute a full course load?	Students must take a minimum of 12 credits to meet visa requirements. Most students take 12 - 16 credits. 18 credits by special approval only.
How and when do students register for classes?	Students provide a list of preferred courses to the International Programs Office, who works with the Registrar's Office to register the students.

What is the approximate cost of housing per month?	\$3740 per semester for residence halls. Apartments can be \$300-500 additional, but students may do their own cooking.
Website or information on cost of living and/or total cost for semester	Housing, meals, fees, insurance, books, living is estimated to be \$10,060 per semester. Meal plan is required for residence halls. Apartment housing available to students 21 or older, depending on availability. Meal plan is optional for apartments.

We match each incoming exchange student with a peer mentor: https://inside.linfield.edu/ipo/peer-mentor.html Students may enroll in Spanish, Japanese or French language classes. Students have opportunities to collaborate on research, creative projects, presentations and community service. There are excursions to explore the surrounding area. New students are partnered with a current student to help become acquainted with the campus.

Students have the option to sign up for a local friendship family to occasionally spend time with, such as sharing meals or holidays, and to experience life with an American family. Optional Jan Term during the month of January, not included in the exchange, so students will pay for meals and other fees. Courses cost \$280 per credit up to 5 credits, maximum.
