Application procedures	Exchange partner nominates student and sends contact details through the nomination form sent in August/January. Mercer then connects with the student and shares the application portal. Student completes online application. Global Pathways Coordinator reviews all documentation and then issues formal acceptance and the Form DS-2019. Documents are sent to student visa eShipGlobal, a fee covered by the student.
