Application procedures	Exchange partner nominates student and sends contact details through the nomination form sent in August/January. Mercer then connects with the student and shares the application portal. Student completes online application. Global Pathways Coordinator reviews all documentation and then issues formal acceptance and the Form DS-2019. Documents are sent to student via email.

Visa requirements	All non-U.S. citizens must secure a J-1 Exchange Visitor Visa. Mercer University will assist students with issuing a Form DS-2019 and steps to complete the J-1 Exchange Visitor Visa process.	
Expected arrival dates	Semester 1: August 12 <sup>th</sup> -14 <sup>th</sup>	Semester 2: January 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup>
Orientation dates	Semester 1: August 17 <sup>th</sup>	Semester 2: Early January
Is arrival pick-up service provided to exchange students? If yes, how do they apply?	Yes. Students need to inform the Global Pathways Coordinator of their expected arrival date and time to the Atlanta airport to be eligible for pick-up services. Pick up services are not provided for airports or other modes of transportation outside the ATL airport.

Courses available to exchange students	All undergraduate courses are available to exchange students. Students must meet all pre- requisite requirement and their enrollment is dependent upon seats available within the course.	
Restricted courses	Any course above the undergraduate level. Internship courses without prior approval.	
Enrolment requirements	Minimum: 12 credits (approximately 4 courses) Maximum: 18 credits (approximately 6 courses)	
Compulsory language requirements for exchange students	For students whose native language or language of instruction in secondary high school is not English, please see this <u>link</u> for minimum scores for various English language proficiency tests.	
When will student receive the acceptance package?	After completion of the online application, plus one week of processing.	
When will transcript be released?	Transcripts can be requested prior to the end of program completion. Transcripts are processed and mailed through the Office of the Registrar. It is estimated that transcripts will be issued and received within 1 month of program completion.	
Health insurance requirements	All students must have health insurance that meets J-1 Exchange Visitor requirements and Mercer University student health insurance requirements. All students will be automatically billed for the Mercer University Student Health Insurance Plan (MUSHiP). The academic year 2023/2024 cost is \$1,246 per semester. If they have sufficient private insurance, they are able to waive this fee.	

### **Housing:**

Do you provide on-campus housing?	All exchange students will be housed in Mercer University on-campus housing.  All efforts are made to place students with an American student of the same gender. The second desire for placements is to place students with native English speakers of the same gender.
