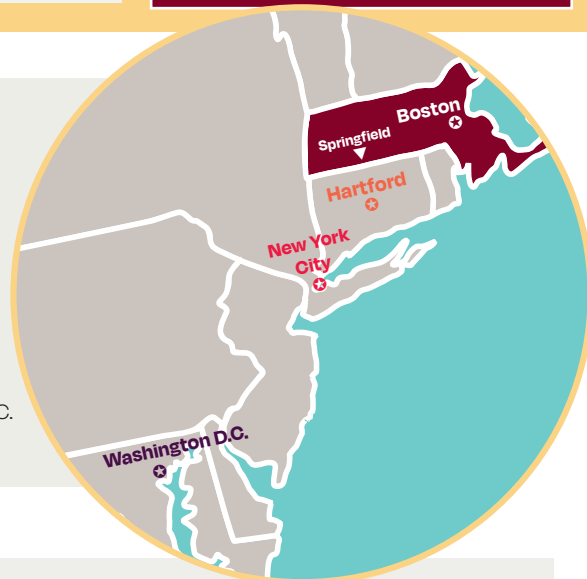
YOUR HOME AWAY FROM HOME

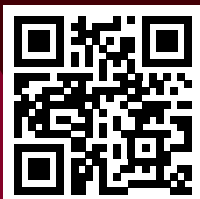
ATHLETICS

Hong Kong Baptist University Semester Exchange

Spend a semester (Aug - Dec or Jan - May) as a visiting student at Springfield College. Take courses across many fields of study, live on campus and be fully integrated into a vibrant campus community!

Participants are guaranteed on campus housing and will be automatically enrolled in mandatory health insurance. Students will receive a travel stipend of \$1,500.

Eligibility:

- Current undergraduate student.
- Must be nominated by Hong Kong Baptist University.
- Be in good financial, disciplinary and academic standing at home university.
- Able to meet Springfield College admission requirements for undergraduate international students.
- English proficiency score of 6.0 IELTS, 105 Duolingo or 70 TOEFL.
