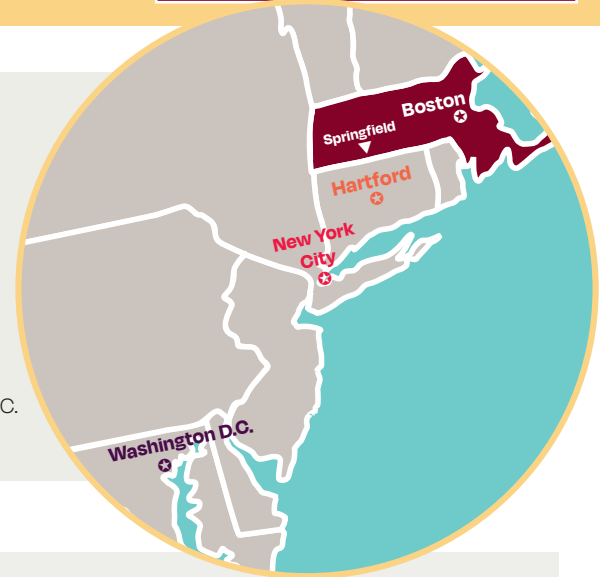
## YOUR HOME AWAY FROM HOME

- New Health Sciences Center!

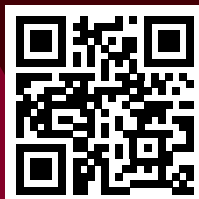
## ATHLETICS

# 2024-2025 Hsu Scholarship

Covers Springfield College direct fees for 1 semester plus a travel stipend up to \$1,500 - valued at over \$10,000!

### Eligibility:

- Undergraduate student studying in a field related to sport or physical education.
- Student must be enrolled at a partner university in China, Hong Kong or Taiwan.
- Be in good financial, disciplinary and academic standing at home university.
- Able to meet Springfield College admission requirements for undergraduate international students.
- English proficiency score of 6.0 IELTS, 105 Duolingo or 70 TOEFL.
- US citizens are not eligible.
