

國際交換生 International Exchange Students

Eligibility

Registered students from TNUA's international partner institutions are eligible to apply for the Exchange Student (Student Mobility) Programme. Please consult your Home Institution's International Office or relevant department for internal selection procedures and nomination details.

Applicants must be officially nominated by their Home Institution through the TNUA online portal before they can proceed with their individual applications.

Nomination and Application Process

The application process is conducted entirely online via the [TNUA Inbound Exchange System](#). (Open from Jan 1 to March 31)

For Home Institution Coordinators: International partners with an existing Partnership Agreement, MoU, or Exchange Student Agreement must first register an account on the portal. Once the account is verified by TNUA, coordinators may log in to nominate their selected students by providing the required candidate information.

For Nominated Students: Upon successful nomination, students will receive an automated notification email from the system. To activate the account for the first time, students must click on the "**Forget (Password)**" link to set up their personal login credentials.

Once logged in, students are required to complete the online application form, which includes personal background information and the selection of the intended department or graduate institute. All supporting documents must be uploaded directly to the portal to finalize the submission.

Application Requirements

Please prepare the following documents in digital format (PDF or JPG) for upload:

1. **Online Application Form** (To be completed within the system)
2. **Copy of Passport**
3. **Two Passport-sized Photos** (Digital headshots)
4. **Official Academic Transcript of Records**
5. **Letter of Recommendation**
6. **Curriculum Vitae (CV)**
7. **Study Plan**
8. **Portfolio or Audition File**
9. **Certificate of Language Proficiency** (Refer to the requirements below)

Note on Portfolios: A Portfolio/Audition file is **not required** for students applying to the following institutions: Dance Department at Purchase College, WAAPA Edith Cowan

University, Ohio State University, and University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign, unless specifically requested by the department.

Language Proficiency Requirements

As the majority of lectures at TNUA are conducted in Mandarin, applicants are highly encouraged to possess sufficient Mandarin proficiency to ensure understanding of instruction. The specific requirements per department/institute are as follows:

Undergraduate

- **Department of Fine Arts:** Mandarin ability equivalent to A2 level.
- **Department of Traditional Music:** Mandarin ability equivalent to B1 level.
- **Department of Theatre:** Mandarin ability equivalent to B1 level.
- **Department of Filmmaking:** Mandarin ability equivalent to B2 level.
- **Department of New Media Art:** Mandarin ability equivalent to A2 level and need to submit a self-introduction video in Mandarin.
- **Department of Animation:** Submit a two-minute self-introduction video in Mandarin.

Postgraduate

- **Graduate Institute of Fine Arts:** Mandarin ability equivalent to A2 level.
- **Graduate Institute of Trans-disciplinary Arts:** Mandarin ability equivalent to A2 level.
- **Graduate Institute of Traditional Music:** Mandarin ability equivalent to B2 level.
- **Graduate Institute of Theatre Arts and Playwriting:** Mandarin ability equivalent to B2 level.
- **Graduate Institute of Filmmaking:** Mandarin ability equivalent to B2 level.
- **Graduate Institute of New Media Art:** Mandarin ability equivalent to A2 level and need to submit a self-introduction video in Mandarin.
- **Graduate Institute of Architecture and Cultural Heritage:** Mandarin ability equivalent to B1 level.
- **Graduate Institute of Arts and Humanities Education:** Mandarin ability equivalent to B2 level.
- **Graduate Institute of Transdisciplinary Study on Creative Writing and Literature:** Mandarin ability equivalent to C2 level.

For departments not listed above, submission of a Mandarin proficiency certificate is not mandatory; however, basic communicative Mandarin is strongly recommended.
