ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Fall Semester 2025: Semester: 1 Sept 2025 –18 Jan 2026 Arrival Day: 19 August, 2025

Spring Semester 2026: Semester: 19 Jan 2026 – 7 June 2026 Arrival Day: 12 January, 2026 (preliminary)

Examination period is included in semester period. There is no official break in the academic calendar for Christmas or Easter. However, in practice there is usually a break in classes over the Christmas/New Year and Easter periods, including public holidays.

NOMINATION

Nominations shall be submitted via our online system SoleMove (partner universities will receive login details via email).

Nomination periods: Fall Semester: 15 March–31 March Spring Semester: 15 September–30 September

APPLICATION

Once the nominations have been submitted students receive an email with the login details that are required for the online application.

Application periods: Fall semester: 1 April–15 April Spring Semester: 1 October–15 October

ARRIVAL DAY

On Arrival Day student mentors meet the international students at the airport in Copenhagen and at the railway station in Lund. They accompany them from the railway station to the Arrival Day venue, where students check in and Welcome Packages are distributed. ORIENTATION PROGRAM & SWEDISH LANGUAGE COURSE

We offer an extensive 1 or 2 week Orientation Program, free of charge to exchange students. It includes some lectures in the Swedish language and an introduction to the university and the cities of Lund and Helsingborg, tours and social activities. The language course renders academic credits. Throughout the semester, different social activities are also organized.

Course load

1.5 Swedish university credits equal 1.5 ECTS-credits, representing one week of full-time studies. Exchange students are expected to take a full-time course load of 30 credits per semester. Course modules generally vary in scope from 7.5 credits to 15 credits. The study rate lies between 25% and 100%. Examination may take various forms and can be based on active participation in seminars, oral presenta- tions-individually and in groups-, written examinations in the form of papers and critical reflections on the course literature.

Restrictions

Exchange students coming on an agreement with the Faculty of Social Sciences, or one of the Faculty of Social Sciences' departments, must take at least half of their credits (15 ECTS) at the Faculty of Social Sciences. While students may include external courses in their applications, they are neither prioritized nor guaranteed admission to courses outside the Faculty of Social Sciences.

GRADING

Hard copies are only sent upon request by the home university.

HOUSING

To find somewhere to live, most international students apply through LU Accommodation, which manages a limited number of rooms and flats in Lund, Helsingborg and Malmö. The application dates and deadlines may vary, and exchange students are strongly recommended to apply as soon as possible.
