Unit Outlines / Course Syllabus ECU Handbook	Students can select from a range of ECU units across multiple Schools. Some restrictions may apply to units from WAAPA and other specialist programs, ie Nursing and Education.	
Unit Availability - Teaching Timetable	The timetable is published in October each year for the following year.

Credit Point System & Study Loads Study Load for International Students Credit Point System Explained	A full-time study load at ECU is 45 to 60 credit points per semester. A typical undergraduate unit is 15 credit points. A typical postgraduate unit is 20 credit points.	
Academic Transcripts	At the completion of their studies, students will be issued with a digital ECU academic transcript via My eEquals . My eEquals is an online portal that gives students secure access anytime, anywhere to certified academic documents. They can then share this with their home university via a secure link.	
Accommodation	On-campus accommodation is limited and is not guaranteed for exchange students. Students that wish to apply for on-campus housing can do so after they have applied for admission and been issued an offer to study at ECU. We recommend students submit an application for housing as soon as possible after offer acceptance.	
Admissions - Students will be emailed application instructions following acceptance of their nomination.		
Admission Closing Dates	Future Students Important Dates - Students are encouraged to submit their applications early to ensure they receive and accept an offer with plenty of time to apply for a student visa and enrol in their preferred units.

Health Insurance	Australian Student Visa holders are required to have Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for the duration of their visa. ECU can arrange the required OSHC for students through ECU's preferred provider, Medibank . Details for the OSHC fees will be outlined on the students offer letter.
