Language of instruction & language requirements	Non-native English language speakers only If a student is applying only for 1 trimester (semester), then they need to provide an endorsement letter from their home university with the following sentence: <i>"We have assessed that that the required B2 level is met in all four components (reading, writing, listening and speaking) of the CEF as the student.. (full name)...has been taught and examined in English".</i> If a student is applying for a full year programme, then they need to provide evidence of passing one of the following, accepted English language tests.
