Application deadlines	<p>After the nomination period has ended, we will send a list of documents to your students, which they need to hand in to finalise their enrolment at Witten/Herdecke University.</p> <p>The application documents must reach us: Winter semester: by September 1 Summer semester: by March 1</p> <p>Please note: If your students need a visa for coming to Germany or if they fall under the so-called “REST Directive” (non-EU students holding a residence permit of another EU member state, except for Denmark and Ireland), they should prepare their documents well in advance.
