> how to choose the classes

For the Erasmus/International mobility students, it's possible to choose classes in different Departments, degrees and years. Guest students are invited to organize a personal plan of the studies, in the learning agreement before the arrival in Bologna and with some changes, during, in Bologna.

*For the required skills' level of the classes it's important to meet the teacher, with a portfolio.

> classes and languages

Art classes are mainly practical classes, but in all the Degree Courses are offered theoretical classes (Aesthetics, Art History, Anthropology, Semiotic, and others). The teaching language is Italian: a basic knowledge of Italian is recommended for the art classes, where English is also in use for many teachers, but a higher level of Italian (intermediate or advanced) is required for the theoretical classes.

> credits

Classes assigning 12 or 10 credits are the main yearly classes in each Degree Course: guest students attending for one semester only will receive half of the credits (6 or 5). Classes assigning 6 or 8 credits are held for one semester. Some of them are scheduled in the first semester only, some others in the second semester only, but few classes are held in both semesters. At the beginning of the academic year the time table (ORARI DELLE LEZIONI) published in www.ababo.it shows what scheduled in the first semester.
