Language of Instruction	All courses are taught in English except for foreign language classes.
Courses	<ul> <li>Exchange students can only enroll in <u>undergraduate courses</u> offered in the College of Arts &amp; Sciences and the School of Management. <u>NOTE: Dual-Degree Teacher Program and other special programs are NOT offered to exchange students.</u> Most USF courses are offered at 4 credits each and most exchange students enroll in 3 to 4 courses (12 - 16 credits) per semester. Exchange students cannot exceed 18 credits nor register less than 12 credits per semester and must maintain full-time status.</li> <li>Fall 2024 courses will be available late March or early April: <a href="http://myusf.usfca.edu/onestop/registration/class-schedule-final-exams">http://myusf.usfca.edu/onestop/registration/class-schedule-final-exams</a></li> </ul>

Exchange students cannot begin the USFrooms online housing application until they have been assigned their USF ID and username. Housing assignments are based on availability and some resident halls are reserved for specific USF student populations such as first year students, sophomore students, and graduate students only. Note: Current exchange students have been assigned to live in the Pacific Wing residence hall and requires a meal plan. Therefore, it is very likely that Pacific Wing will be offered to exchange students pending availability for the Academic Year 2024-2025. <ul> <li>Exchange students who do not have a U.S. passport must obtain a J-1 visa to enter the U.S. and attend courses at USF. Exchange students will be required to complete the Certification of Finances form (as part of the exchange application). It is very important because without it USF cannot issue out the DS-2019 form that exchange students need in order to get the J-1 visa from a U.S. Embassy in their home country.</li> <li>Exchange students must demonstrate that they have the financial means to support their academic expenses (housing, meals, insurance, transportation, books, etc.) while they attend USF. Exchange students will need to have bank documentation verifying that they have at least \$13,521 US dollars per semester in available funding for the Academic Year 2024-2025.
