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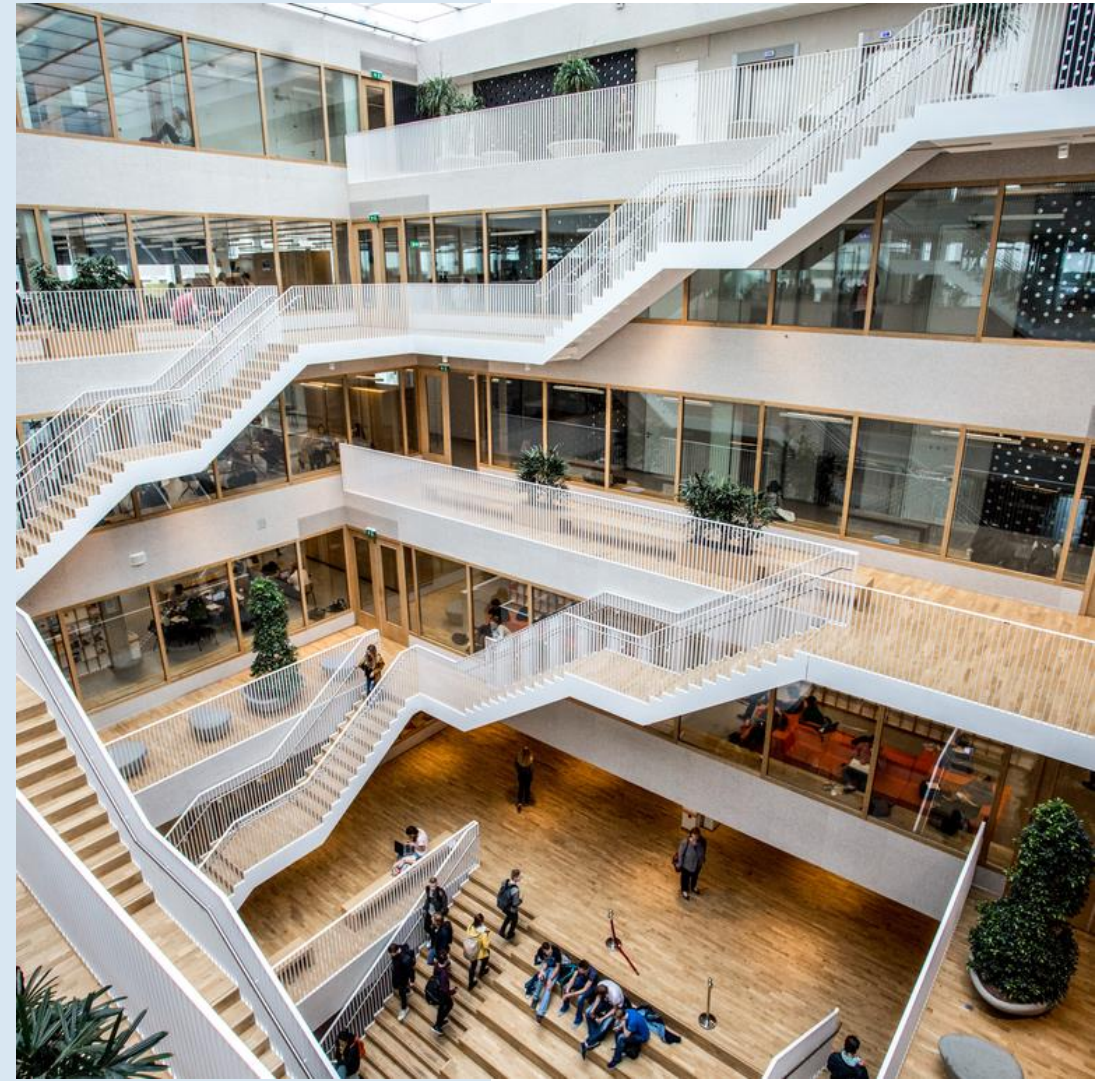

All courses are in English



RSM EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES

Bachelor Exchange programme:

- Open to 3rd year Bachelor students
- Participation in autumn and/or spring
- Autumn option: September till December
- Spring options: January or February till March, June or July or April till June or July

Master Exchange programme:

- Open to Master / (post)graduate students
- Participation in autumn and/or spring
- Short exchange programme options in autumn and spring (1 block of courses, 7 to 8 weeks)
- Also open to our MBA students from partner schools

MBA Exchange programme:

- Exclusively for students of MBA partner schools
- Autumn only, see also website [Incoming MBA Exchange](#)

BACHELOR EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

Academic calendar:

- **Autumn semester:** Beginning of September – end of December
- **Winter/Spring semester:** January or February till March, June or July, April till June or July
- **Curriculum:** 1st, 2nd and 3rd year courses from BSc in International Business Administration.
- **Minimum workload:** 20 EC in Fall and 12-30 EC in Spring (depending on blocks).

Also possible to participate in a course at Erasmus' other faculties (school of Economics and Medicine excluded).
- **Special feature (optional):**

Fall: students can also participate in ONE [RSM-minor](#) with a workload of 15 EC and/or ONE elective with a workload of 5 EC.

Spring: students can choose one module per block from a [track](#), one or two electives, and /or regular courses. Both the modules as well as the electives have a workload of 5 EC. Furthermore, we offer "International Business: The Dutch Way" specially designed for exchange students. Includes case studies, guest lectures, company visits and excursions.
- **Class profile:** Average age: 20 and in the last or penultimate year of undergraduate business studies. Many work part-time or do summer internships. Around 60% of the total class has an international background.
- **Introduction activity:** Usually 1 full day, prior to start of the exchange programme
- **Buddy system:** Available, we call them Exchange Ambassadors

MASTER EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

Academic calendar:

- **Autumn semester:** Full term (September- December, Block 1-3) or single block
Block 1: beginning of September – end of October
Block 2: end of October – end of December
- **Winter/Spring semester:** Full term (January – Mid May, Block 3-4) or single block
Block 3: end of January – mid March
Block 4: mid March – mid May
Block 5: mid May – end of June
- **Short exchange possible:** 1 block of courses
- **Curriculum:** In Fall, core or in Spring, elective courses from most specialised
[Master of Science Programmes](#)
- **Minimum workload:** Minimum 12 EC (1 block), 18 EC (2 blocks), 20EC (3 blocks) Fall = 20 EC)
- **Special feature (optional):** Participation in [International Consultancy Project](#), a real-life consultancy project carried out by an international team of students and supervised by both an academic and corporate coach. Open to full term students only, either in Fall or Spring.
- **Class profile:** Average age: 24. Most students have some relevant working experience through internships, business projects, part-time management jobs or start-ups. All students are Master students or visiting MBA students from our partner schools. 35% of students have an international background.
- **Introduction activity:** Usually 1 full day, prior to start of exchange programme
- **Buddy system:** Available, we call those Exchange Ambassadors
