Ulsan City is

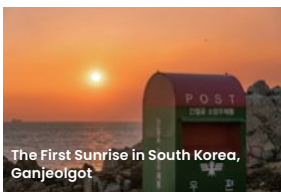

Ulsan's urban area is formed around the Taewha River, bordering Busan Metropolitan City, Korea's second-largest city, to the south, and encountering Gyeongju City, a millennium-old capital, to the north.

Center of South Korea's Economy

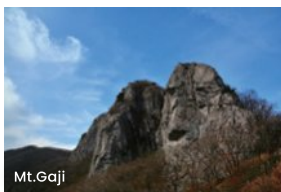
It has been a globally renowned industrial city that has been driving Korea's economic growth. Ulsan stands as the largest industrial cluster in Korea, specializing in automotive, shipbuilding, maritime, and petrochemical industries, with an annual export value reaching approximately USD 57 billion.

The Great Outdoors

Ulsan is not only famous for its economic prowess but also for its breathtaking natural scenery. It is a tourist city where mountains and coastlines coexist harmoniously. It features splendid natural attractions such as Ganjeolgot, known for being the first place to witness sunrise in Northeast Asia, along with its beaches. Additionally, it boasts beautiful mountains like Mt. Gaji and Mt. Sinbulsan, often referred to as Korea's Alps. Furthermore, it is home to globally recognized cultural heritages like the Ulsan Rock Carvings and the Gacheonli Cliff Inscriptions.
